Migration profile of Poland


- Scale of flows


Migration profile of Poland: outflows






Labour immigration

Number of declarations issued



- Strategic document *Polish Migration Policy the Current State* of *Play and Proposed Actions*' (Ministry of Interior 2012)

- New legal acts: Abolition Act 2012, New Alien Act,
 Naturalization Act
